ITRG contacted The Unite Group to ascertain quantities and approximate value of their redundant IT equipment. At which point a convenient collection date and time was agreed.

ITRG collected all IT equipment from the customers containment rooms, at all times observing the clients health and safety rules, and any restrictions with respect of access points etc.

At the collection point the customer was given a completed copy of the Duty of Care: Controlled Waste Transfer note and our Service Level Agreement.

All IT equipment from the collection was unloaded at our recycling plant and logged, and all asset tags or identifying labels removed. Any equipment containing data was segregated and held in our secure area until all data carrying devices were erased and/or destroyed.

After the data destruction process was completed, the equipment was cleaned, refurbished and sent for sale through our many sales channels.

A certificate of data destruction, asset reports and WEEE certification was made available to the customer via our Online Reporting System.

After the sales process was completed, the customer was notified of the final value and a payment was made to The Charlie & Carter Foundation.
